Finished Scarf

Dimensions:

5 1/2" x 60"

Finished Hat

Circumference:

22 inches

Materials:

2 ske Northampton color Burgundy
Size 8 straight and double pointed needles
OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE.

Gauge:

Approx. 6.25 sts per inch in cable patt

Abbreviations:

FC = Front Cross; place 2 sts on cable needle and hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle.

BC = Back Cross; place 2 stson cable needle and hold to back, k2, k2 from cable needle.

M1k = Make 1 knitwise; insert tip of RH needle from back to front into strand running between the sts on right and left hand needles, insert tip of LH needle into the front of this stitch and knit it.

M1p = Make 1 purlwise; make as for M1k except slipping it entirely on to the LH needle and purl into the back of it.

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Alternating Cable Pattern:

Row 1 & all WS rows: K1, p8, k1.

Row 2 (RS): P1, FC, k4, p1.

Row 4: P1, k8, p1.

Row 6: As Row 2.

Row 8: P1, k4, BC, p1.

Row 10: As Row 4.

Row 12: As Row 8.

Alternating Cable

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Braid Cable Pattern:

Row 1 & all WS rows: K1, p6, k1.

Row 2 (RS): P1, FC, k2, p1.

Row 4: P1, k6, p1.

Row 6: P1, k2, BC, p1.

Row 8: As Row 4.

Scarf:

With straight needles, CO32 sts.

Knit 2 rows garter st.

Next row: K2, p1, k8, p2, k6, p2, k8, p1, k2.

Row 1: K2, work Alternating Cable patt, work Braid Cable patt, work Alternating Cable patt, k2.

Continue to work as established for 60", ending with a row 12 of Alternating Cable patt. Work 2 rows garter st. Bind off.

Hat:

Cast on 4 sts. While dividing onto double pointed needles, knit into the front and back of each st 3 times, k1. (7 sts)
Join in round.

Rnds 1-15: Knit.

Rnd 2: *M1k, k1, rep from * (14 sts)

Rnd 4: *M1k, k2, rep from * (21 sts)

Rnd 6: *M1k, k3, rep from * (28 sts)

Rnd 8: *M1k, k4, rep from * (35 sts)

Rnd 10: *M1k, k1, BC, rep from * (42 sts)

Rnd 12: *M1k, k6, rep from * (49 sts)

Rnd 14: *M1k, k3, BC, rep from * (56 sts)

Rnd 16: *M1p, FC, k4, rep from * (63 sts)

Rnd 17 and all foll alt rnds: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rnd 18: *M1p, p1, k8, rep from * (70 sts)

Rnd 20: *M1k, p2, FC, k4, rep from * (77 sts)

Rnd 22: *M1k, k1, p2, k4, BC, rep from * (84 sts)

Rnd 24: *M1k, k2, p2, k8, rep from * (91 sts)

Rnd 26: *M1k, k3, p2, k4, BC, rep from * (98 sts)

Rnd 28: *M1k, BC, p2, FC, k4, rep from * (105 sts)

Rnd 30: *M1k, k5, p2, k8, rep from * (112 sts)

Rnd 32: *M1p, FC, k2, p2, FC, k4, rep from * (119 sts)

Rnd 34: *M1p, k6, p2, k4, BC, rep from * (126 sts)

Work without increasing from this point on, working the alternating and braid cables as established. Work until piece measures 8.5" from top or desired length. Bind off loosely. Sew in ends and block if desired.

(Hint: for a slightly tighter brim, try working p2tog in each of the purled sections about an inch before the end.)
