

## #245 One Skein Shrug

Designed by Kirsten Hipsky



### Finished Sizes:

15.75" back width, 12" arm circumference

### Materials:

1 skein Valley Yarns Northampton (100% wool, 247yds/100g) color 27 merlot heather  
US size 8 3/2" and 16" circular needles or size needed to obtain gauge  
Stitch markers

### Gauge:

16 sts and 24 rows = 4" in St st on size 8 needles or size needed to obtain gauge

### Abbreviations:

K2tog = knit 2 together

Ssk = slip two sts, one by one, as if to knit. Insert tip of LH needle up into both sts and knit them together

Yo = yarn over

Sl2tog-k1-p2sso = slip 2 sts as if to knit 2 together, knit 1, pass both slipped sts over knit st

Pm = place marker

Sm = slip marker

### Directions:

Using long-tail cast on, CO 59 sts.

Setup Row 1: K across.

Reup Row 2: K1, p to last st, k1.

Work Tulip Lace Stitch as follows:

Row 1 (RS): K1, ssk, yo, \*k1, yo, sl2tog-k1-p2sso, yo; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k1, yo, k2tog, k1.

Row 2 and all WS rows: K1, p to last st, k1.

Row 3: K1, ssk, yo, \*k5, yo, sl2tog-k1-p2sso, yo; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k5, yo, k2tog, k1.

Row 5: As Row 3.

Row 7: K3, \*yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k3; rep from \* to end.

Row 9: As Row 1.

Row 10 (WS): K1, p9, pm, p8 for right sleeve, pm, p23 for back, pm, p8 for left sleeve, pm, p9, k1.

Row 11: K1, ssk, yo, k5, yo, k2tog, sm, \*kfb, k to 1 st before next marker, kfb, sm; rep from \* to last marker, ssk, yo, k5, yo, k2tog, k1.

Row 12 and all foll WS rows: K1, p to last st, k1.

Row 13: As Row 11.

Row 15: K3, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, sm, \*kfb, k to 1 st before next marker, kfb, sm; rep from \* to last marker, k2, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k3.

Row 17: K1, ssk, yo, k1, yo, sl2tog-k1-p2sso, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, sm, \*kfb, k to 1 st before next marker, kfb, sm; rep from \* to last marker, ssk, yo, k1, yo, sl2tog-k1-p2sso, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, k1.

Row 18: As Row 2.

Repeat rows 11-18 until sleeve sections have 48 sts each and back section has 63 sts.

Next Row (RS): K1, ssk, yo, k5, yo, k2tog, remove marker, with shorter circular needle, knit to next marker, remove marker. Join these sleeve sts in the round.

Left sleeve:

Rnd 1: \*K1, yo, sl2tog-k1-p2sso, yo; rep from \* around.

Rnd 2 and all alt rnds: Knit.

Rnd 3: \*K5, yo, sl2tog-k1-p2sso, yo; rep from \* around.

Rnd 5: As Rnd 3.

Rnd 7: \*Yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k3; rep from \* around.

Rnd 9: As Rnd 1.

Rnds 10 and 11: Knit.

Bind off left sleeve sts purlwise.

Join yarn at left armhole and knit across back to next marker, remove marker, with shorter circular needle, knit across right sleeve sts and work as for left sleeve. Rejoin yarn at right armhole and work ssk, yo, k5, yo, k2tog, k1 for the right lace border.

Work Rows 12-16 of pattern as follows:

Row 12 and all WS rows: K1, p to last st, k1.

Row 13: K1, ssk, yo, k5, yo, k2tog, k to last 10 sts, ssk, yo, k5, yo, k2tog, k1.

Row 15: K3, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2, k to last 10 sts, k2, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k3.

Row 16: As row 12.

Work Rows 1-9 of lace pattern across all sts.

Purl one row, knit one row, bind off knitwise on the wrong side.

Sew in all loose ends, sewing gap at armholes shut if desired. Block shrug, steaming if necessary to make edge lay flat.

### Larger Sizes:

You can repeat rows 11-18 of the raglan increases until sleeve circumference and back fit comfortably, so long as you end with a row 18. Then work the rest of the shrug as written. However, you will almost definitely need a second skein.
