

## #368 Crocheted Rabbit

### Finished Size:

About 4" tall

### Materials:

1 sk each of Valley Yarns Amherst (100% merino, 109 yds / 50g) colors light gray and powder pink  
 US size G/6 (4.00mm) crochet hook  
 scraps of black yarn  
 1 locking stitch marker

### Finishing:

Sew inner ears to outer ears. Sew ears to body. Embroider eyes with black and nose/mouth with pink. Bury all ends withing body.

### Gauge:

about 4 sts = 1" in sc

### Abbreviations:

ch: chain  
 rep: repeat  
 sc: single crochet  
 sl st: slip stitch  
 sc2tog: single crochet 2 together – draw up a loop in each of the next 2 sts, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook

### Body:

For stuffing, with gray, loosely wind a ball of yarn about 8" around.

With gray, ch2 - Place a marker in the first st of every round, moving it upwards into the first st of every new round.

Rnd 1: 6sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6sc)

Rnd 2: 2sc in each sc around. (12sc)

Rnd 3: \*1sc in next sc, 2sc in next sc; rep rom \* 5 more times. (18sc)

Rnd 4: \*1sc in each of next 2sc, 2sc in next sc; rep from \* 5 more times. (24sc)

Rnd 5: \*1 sc in each of next 3sc, 2sc in next sc; rep from \* 5 more times. (30sc)

Rnds 6 through 14: 1sc in each sc around.

Place ball of yarn in the middle of body and finish crocheting the body around it.

Rnd 15: \*Sc2tog in next 2sc, 1sc in each of next 3sc; rep from \* 5 more times. (24sc)

Rnd 16: \*Sc2tog in next 2sc, 1sc in each of next 2sc; rep from \* 5 more times. (18sc)

Rnd 17: \*Sc2tog in next 2sc, 1sc in next sc; rep from \* 5 more times. (12sc)

Round 18: \*Sc2tog in next 2sc; rep from \* 5 more times. (6sc)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### Outer ear - make 2:

Row 1: With gray, ch2 , 3sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn.

Row 2: Ch1, 2sc in first sc, 1sc in next sc, 2sc in last sc, turn. (5sc)

Rows 3 through 11: Ch1, 1sc in each sc across, turn.

Cut yarn, fasten off.

### Inner ear - make 2:

Row 1: With pink, ch2, 3sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn.

Rows 2 through 6: Ch1, 1sc in each sc across, turn.

Cut yarn, fasten off.
