



## #535 Bits and Pieces Cowl

This single crochet cowl is one of the simplest and fastest ways to creatively use up any soft, wearable scraps of yarn you have or to recreate the vibrant stripes as pictured.

### Finished Size:

55" circumference and 9.5" deep

### Yarn:

1 skein each of [Valley Yarns Berkshire Bulky](#) (85%Wool/15% Alpaca, 108yds/100g) colors: 17 Wine (C1), 35 Forest (C2), 34 Hunter (C3), 1 Cream (C4), 42 Dark Grey Heather (C5)

### Hook:

US size M/N (9.00mm) or size needed to get gauge

### Gauge:

about 10 sts = 4" in single crochet

### Abbreviations:

ch: chain; sc: single crochet; PM: place marker in the st just made; ea: each; st(s): stitch(es)

### Directions:

With C1, ch125

Round 1: Being careful not to twist the chain, bring the hook around to the first ch, 1sc in first ch to join in the round, PM, 1sc in ea ch around to marker. (125 sc)

Round 2: 1sc in marked st, PM, 1sc in ea ch around to marker. (125 sc)

Repeat Round 2 five more times with C1.

Repeat Round 2 two more times with C2.

Repeat Round 2 three more times with C3.

Repeat Round 2 nine more times with C4.

Repeat Round 2 six more times with C5. Fasten off.

### Finishing:

Weave in ends and gently block to settle stitches.
