



## #524 Cranberry Scarf

A simple mistake rib is worked lengthwise across this cozy scarf, making it stretch gently around the neck like a sweater.

### Finished Size:

about 60" and 8" wide

### Yarn:

2 skeins Valley Yarns [Enfield](#) (50% Wool/40% Acrylic/10% Alpaca, 100g/110yds) color 7350

### Needles:

US size 10 (6.00mm) or size needed to get gauge

### Gauge:

3.5 sts = 1" in stitch pattern

### Abbreviations:

k: knit; p: purl; rep: repeat; st(s): stitch(es)

### Stitch pattern (multiple of 4 sts +1):

Row 1: \*K3, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

Repeat this row for stitch pattern.

### Directions:

Loosely cast on 209 sts.

Work even in stitch pattern for 8" or desired width of scarf.

Bind off all sts. Sew in all loose ends and block.
