



## #575 Crocheted Lace Jar Covers

### Sizes:

Moroccan Lace: for standard Quarts or wide mouth Pints - 3" across bottom, height to suit jar  
Picket Fence: for standard Pints or wide mouth Half-Pints

### Yarn:

Moroccan Lace: 1 skein Valley Yarns [Huntington](#) (75% Superwash Merino Wool/25% Nylon, 50g/218yd) color 0010 Natural (about 90 yds used)  
Picket Fence: 1 cone Valley Yarns [Colrain Lace](#) (50% Merino/50% Tencel, 1,540 yd/8.8 oz) color natural (about 60 yds used)

### Hook:

US size E (3.5mm) or size needed to get gauge

### Gauge:

Moroccan Lace: 6dc = 1", 7 rnds = 3" in side stitch pattern  
Picket Fence: 6 sts and 5 rows = 1" in pattern stitch

Two crocheted adornments can turn ordinary household jars into beautiful candle lanterns, or just provide a pretty place to store your needles.

The lace pattern on Moroccan Lace evokes the intricate filigree metalwork of North African lanterns and will add just a touch of exotic elegance to your holiday decor.

The simple filet crochet structure of Picket Fence is made a bit playful by a spray of picots along the top edge.

**IMPORTANT!** Please use only LED flameless candles in your jars. Valley Yarns are not tested for flammability. Please do not use with open flame.



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### Moroccan Lace Jar Cover:

Base:

Ch4, sl st to 1st ch to form ring

Rnd 1: Ch2 (counts as 1dc on this and all rounds of base), 11dc into ring, join with sl st to 2nd ch of ch 2. (12dc)

Rnd 2: Ch2, 1dc in same st, 2dc in ea st around, join with sl st to 2nd ch of ch 2. (24dc)

Rnd 3: Ch2, 2dc in next st, \*1dc in next st, 2dc in next st; rep from \* around, join with sl st to 2nd ch of ch 2. (36dc)

Rnd 4: Ch2, 1dc in next st, 2dc in next st, \*1dc in ea of next 2 sts, 2dc in next st; rep from \* around, join with sl st to 2nd ch of ch 2. (48dc)

Rnd 5: Ch2, 1dc in ea of next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, \*1dc in ea of next 3 sts, 2dc in next st; rep from \* around, join with sl st to 2nd ch of ch 2. (60dc)

Sides:

Rnd 1: Ch2 (counts as 1blhdc), 1blhdc in ea st around, join with sl st to 2nd ch of ch 2. (60 blhdc)

Rnd 2: Ch2 (counts as 1hdc), 1hdc in ea st around, join with sl st to 2nd ch of ch 2. (60 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch3 (counts as 1dc), 2dc in same st, ch1, sk 3 sts, \*3dc in next st, ch1, sk3 sts; rep from \* around, join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 3. (15 groups of 3dcs)

Rnd 4: Sl st to next st, ch1, 1sc in same st, picot, \*ch2, (1sc, ch6, 1sc) in ch1 sp, \*\* ch2, sk 1, 1sc in next st, picot; rep from \* around ending at \*\*, DO NOT JOIN.

Rnd 5: \*Ch6, 3dc in next ch 6 sp, ch6, sk picot, 1sc in next sc, 3sc in next ch 6 sp, 1sc in next sc, ch3, sk picot, 1sc in next sc, 3sc in next ch 6 sp, 1sc in next sc; rep from \* around, DO NOT JOIN.

Rnd 6: Ch6 (counts as 1tr, ch2), \*1dc in next dc, 3dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc, ch2, (1tr in next sc, 1dc in center sc of 3sc\*\*, 1tr in next sc) twice, ch2; rep from \* ending at \*\*, sl st to 4th ch of ch 6.

Rnd 7: Ch2 (counts as 1dc), \*2dc in ch 2 sp, 1dc in ea of next 5 dcs, 2dc in ch 2 sp, 1dc in next tr and dc, sk 2 tr, 1dc in next dc and tr; rep from \* around, join with sl st to the 2nd ch of ch 2. (65dc)

Rnd 8: Ch1, 1sc in same st, 1sc in next 9 sts, sk 1 st, \*1sc in next 10 sts, sk 1st; rep from\* around, join with sl st to first sc. (60sc)  
Repeat Rnds 2-8 once more or 0.5" shorter than desired height.  
Repeat Rnd 2 once more.

Rnd 9: Ch3 (counts as 1hdc and ch1), sk 1 st, \*1hdc in next st, ch1, sk 1 st; rep from \* around, join with sl st to 2nd ch of ch 3.

Rnd 10: Ch2 (counts as 1hdc), 1hdc in ch 1 sp, \*1hdc in next st, 1hdc in ch 1 sp; rep from \* around, join with sl st to 2nd ch of ch 2.

Finishing:

Fasten off and weave in ends. Thread a strand of yarn through the eyelets from Round 9 and tie a small bow.

Gently block cover over intended jar to open lace.

### Picket Fence Jar Cover:

Ch54, sl st to form a ring, being careful not to twist.

Rnd 1: Ch1, 1sc in same st, 1sc in ea st around, join with sl st to first sc. (54sc)

Rnd 2: Ch3 (counts as 1dc and ch1),\* sk 1 sc, 1dc in ea of next 2 sts, ch1; rep from \* around, ending with 1dc in last st, join with sl st to 2nd ch of ch 3.

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 to 0.5" less than desired height.

Repeat Rnd 2 once more.

Rnd 3: Sl st into next ch 1 sp, ch1, 1sc in same sp, \*(1dc, picot) 3 times into next ch 1 sp, 1sc in next ch 1 sp; rep from \* around, ch2, sl st to first sc.

Finishing:

Fasten off and weave in ends. Gently block cover over intended jar to open lace.

### Abbreviations:

blhdc: back loop half double crochet (see Special Stitches); ch: chain; dc: double crochet; ea: each; hdc: half double crochet; sc: single crochet; sk: skip; sp: space; st(s): stitch(es); tr: treble crochet

### Special Stitches:

picot: ch3, sl st to side of the stitch below  
back loop half double crochet: hdc as normal but through the back loop only of the st below
